PG&E Electric Rate Schedule

Eligibility

The San Mateo County Energy Watch Program provides energy efficiency consulting, rebates, and turn-key installation of efficient equipment to commercial PG&E electricity customers in San Mateo County. Multi-family buildings are eligible for assistance in their common areas only. Some very large businesses, schools, non-profit businesses and municipal facilities may have additional requirements to participate, so be sure to confirm eligibility with your San Mateo County Energy Watch Energy Specialist.

Process

- 1. Qualifying businesses receive a free energy audit and report detailing recommended energy-saving measures, expected installation costs, estimated energy savings and rebate amount.
- 2. When the Customer has reviewed the report and decided to implement the San Mateo County Energy Watch recommendations, the Program will make pre-screened contractors available to perform the work at a time that is convenient to the Customer.
- **3.** Finally, San Mateo County Energy Watch will perform a follow-up inspection to confirm the quality of installation. After a successful installation, the Customer is responsible to the contractor(s) for the portion of installation costs not covered by the rebate, if any.

Restrictions

This Program is available from January 1, 2013 through December 1, 2015 or until all Program funds have been allocated. Funds will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.
